The said Order has been brought to the notice of undersigned today, i.e., 23rd December 2025 around 11.50 a.m. Details of the matter required under SEBI Circular are:

The demand pertains to disallowance of Input Tax Credit (ITC) availed on cargo handling and other related services in respect of coal purchase, alleging non-receipt of services.
Date of receipt of direction or order, including any ad-interim or interim orders, or any other communication from the authority;	The Order has been received by the Company on 22 nd December 2025, 3:38 p.m. of which the undersigned was informed on 23 rd December 2025 at around 11.50 a.m.
